1 Petronas Twin Towers



 Kuala Lumpur City Centre, 50088 Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia

For breathtaking views of the city of Kuala Lumpur, walk up the Petronas Twin Towers. It is world's tallest twin building and once upon a time, world's tallest building until Taipei 101 shot past it. Designed by architect Cesar Pelli with a distinctive post-modern architectural style, it took around 5 years for the twin towers to be completed in 1999 with its building process breaking several records itself. With 88 floors in each tower, the facades of which resemble Islamic art motifs. The sharp needle-like pinnacles you see atop the twin towers are 241-feet tall with one having been made in Korea and the other in Japan.

Inside the twin towers is Suria KLCC, a high-

end, upscale retail center that in addition to luxury retail brands also features an art gallery, aquarium, a science center and a philharmonic theater. Below the building is KLCC Park that has jogging paths with fountains featuring light shows and massive pools to swim in. Possibly the most fascinating aspect of Petronas Towers is the skybridge. The skybridge connects the two towers at the 41st and 42nd floor and can actually slide in and out of the towers. In a given day only 1,000 people are allowed to cross it for which the entry is ticketed.

During high, strong winds the towers actually tend to sway on their spot. Petronas Twin Towers is a popular site for movie shots, especially action sequences. It is at the 86th floor of the towers where the observation deck is situated and stunning views of the city's skyline and landscape can be captured.

2 Sunway Lagoon

Sunway Lagoon is an amazing theme park in Subang Jaya, Malaysia. This theme park was named by Tripadvisor's Travelers Choice as the 4th Best Water Theme Park in Asia in the year 2015. The most outstanding attractions of this theme park are Malaysia's first surf simulator, the Flow Rider, Malaysia's first 5D Waterplexx and the world's largest water ride, Vuvuzela. Sunway Lagoon is divided into a number of sections as - Water Park, Scream Park, Amusement Park, Extreme Park, Wildlife Park and Nickelodeon Lost Lagoon.

3 Putrajaya Bridge

Known as one of the best bridges in Kuala Lumpur and a traveler's favourite for the same reason, the Putrajaya Bridge is a great place for an evening or early morning stroll. Built over a manmade lake, the place boasts of awesome views and makes for some excellent shots for your camera.

The place has quite a few excellent fine dining restaurants to boast of, specially around the pillars. These restaurants have the perfect setting for a romantic dinner

date, making it a must do on a holiday with your someone special. The bridge is built on two levels, with the lower level reserved for transportation and the upper one reserved for joggers and strollers. The upper level resembles a boulevard, and is worth a couple of hours on your KL itinerary.

4 Aquaria KLCC

One of the best Oceanariums in the country and around, the Aquaria KLCC brings you super close to the marine life you've only seen in the movies or read about. View killer sharks in their natural habitats, and over 250 other species of marine life when here. The place also features a lot of interactive sections where you can learn about turtles and other aquatic animals through touch screen kiosks and placards. The most interesting aspect about the Aquaria KLCC is the way your journey proceeds, from a

misty, fog cloaked highland, to a journey down river, passing through rain forests and mangroves, and finally ending at the ocean and Coral Reefs. All in all, this little exotic attraction is a must visit for families and those interested in marine life.

5 Kuala Lumpur Bird Park

Dating back to the late 1880s, the Kuala Lumpur Bird Park is one of the biggest draws for nature lovers and tourists in the city. The place is studded with many other mini attractions, including the Butterfly Park, the National Garden, the Hibiscus and Orchid Garden and an artificial lake. Take a walk along the park and enjoy views of colourful and exotic tropical birds of all shapes and sizes. You can spot countless varieties at the specific spots for

each of the birds. For example, see the pink flamingos perched on one leg at the flamingo pond; count a hundred colours of the parrot at the Parrot World or simply stare in awe at the majesty of the bird at the Hornbill Park. A very interesting part of the park is the Egg Incubation Centre, where you might be able to see the eggs of all these birds, depending on season. The park also has an Education centre, and makes for a very interesting learning experience for both adults and kids.
